2. Footnotes must be styled to comply with the ALWD standard of citation, and they must come after and not before a punctuation mark. Kindly adjust your footnote locations in the article. In terms of citation style, kindly ensure that:

Articles should be cited as:

Author first name, Last name, Title of Article in title case and italics Vol number Journal Title Page number (Year).

eg Jean du Plessis, *Corruption and Gatekeepers* 29 European Business Law Review 1 (2019)

Books should be cited as

Author or Editor First name, Last name, Title of Book in title case and italics, pincite page (Place of Publication; Publisher, Year).

eg Jean du Plessis, *Comparative Corporate Governance*, pincite page (Heidelberg: Springer, 2015)

Official papers follow the above format eg European Central Bank, *Digital Currencies* (2022), at precise URL.

Chapters in books are cited as:

Author or Editor First name, Last name, *Title of Chapter in Title Case and Italics in Title of Book in Title Case and Italics*, pincite page (Place of Publication; Publisher, Year)
