eg Jean du Plessis, *Comparative Corporate Governance*, pincite page (Heidelberg: Springer, 2015)

Official papers follow the above format eg European Central Bank, *Digital Currencies* (2022), at precise URL.

Chapters in books are cited as:

Author or Editor First name, Last name, *Title of Chapter in Title Case* and *Italics* in *Title of Book in tTitle Case and Italics*, pincite page (Place of Publication; Publisher, Year)
